3 Nights Cairo • 4 Night Cruise

Day 1 CAIRO Arrival

Arrive in the land of the Pharaohs. You will be met and assisted by our representative and transferred to your hotel.

Day 2 CAIRO

In the morning you'll visit the Great Pyramids of Giza, the enigmatic Sphinx, and the Egyptian Museum of Antiquities including the treasures to Tutankhamen's Tomb. In the afternoon drive through Old Cairo to visit Al Moallaka Church and Ben Ezra Synagogue, then proceed to Khan El Khalili, one of the world's best known Middle Eastern bazaars. Overnight in Cairo.

Day 3 CAIRO • LUXOR

Morning flight to Luxor. Upon arrival, you will be met and escorted to your ship. Afternoon sightseeing includes Luxor and Karnak Temples, a holy city of pylons, hypostyle halls, colossal statues, shrines and obelisks, built over the centuries and dedicated to the god, his consort, Mut and their son.

Day 4 LUXOR

In the early morning cross the Nile by ferry boat to Luxor's West Bank, Thebes. Sightseeing includes the Valley of the Kings, where some 64 of Egypt's Pharaohs had the palatial resting palaces hewed into the sheer rock. See the Valley of the Queens, Medinet Habu and the Colossi of Memnon.

Day 5 ESNA • EDFU • KOM OMBO

Sail to Esna, where a short walk takes you to the Temple of Khnum, built in the Ptolemaic Period. Continue sailing to Aswan and visit the Temple of Horus, Falcon god. Sail to Kom Ombo for overnight.

Day 6 ASWAN

Morning visit to Kom Ombo Temple with its beautiful mural and exceptional view of the River Nile. Sail to Aswan and visit by "felucca" sailing boat, the Elephantine Island, the Botanical Gardens and the Agha Khan Mausoleum.

Day 7 ASWAN • CAIRO

Disembark after breakfast. Visit the Aswan's Old and High Dams, Philae Temple and the granite quarries. Transfer to Aswan Airport for your flight back to Cairo.

Day 8 CAIRO Departure

Our representative will transfer you to the airport for your flight back home.

* For Monday arrivals, the itinerary is reversed.

Booking Conditions & Other Important Information



AIR TRANSPORTATION: Exclusively with IATA/ARC scheduled Transatlantic carriers.

AIRFARES: Although prices are current at the time of printing or listing, airlines frequently change their prices as a result of fare increases and/or fuel surcharges. Therefore prices may differ when you book for your travel. Please call for our most current prices, which are guaranteed only when paid in full and the airline tickets are issued. Airfares are booked on a certain class of service and are subject to changes and do not include taxes, fees and passenger facility charges. Changes and/or cancellations after issuance of tickets are subject to penalties and as per the rules of each individual airfare and airline selected.

LUGGAGE: Two checked bags (of 50 lbs each) per person. If you make a stopover in Europe or travel by air to the islands, the regulation of a maximum of 44 pounds per person applies. Bags that exceed this allowance excess baggage charges can apply.

HOTELS: Rates are based on standard rooms, run of the house as specified in our brochure and may be substituted with a similar category. All hotels include private facilities, buffet breakfast, service and all taxes. (Dinners only where indicated).

CRUISES: The cruise company reserves the right to alter the itinerary of any cruise for any reason and to substitute the vessel with another for one or more cruises at any time. Disembarkation on islands by tender, subject to weather conditions. Minors under 18 years and children will not be allowed to embark but only if they are accompanied and traveling with a parent or guardian.

MEALS: As listed in the Tour Feature box and itineraries. All Hotels include buffet breakfast and all taxes.

RESERVATIONS / DEPOSITS / FINAL PAYMENT: A deposit of \$250 per person is required 10 days from time of booking. No reservation can be considered firm and no land prices are guaranteed until a deposit has been received. A "final payment due date" will be indicated on your confirmation receipt. Requests within 21 days prior to departure will be processed upon receipt of full payment with a certified check or a credit card. All credit cards are accepted.

SINGLE SUPPLEMENT: For all programs add 50% to the published price.

TRIPLE: For land tours only, deduct 5% per person from the published tour price. For Land and Cruise packages, we must be informed whether the third or fourth in a cabin is a child (2-16) or an adult. We will intum calculate the price and advise you of the exact cost. Only certain categories accommodate 3 and 4 persons.

REFUNDS: Cannot be made for missed or unused sightseeing trips, transfers and hotel accommodations unless our local office approves the refund. **Refund claims must be submitted in writing.**

CANCELLATIONS: For Land Tours,
